Groundswell Announces Annual Art Auction Benefit

NEW YORK, NY – **Groundswell** announces its 2015 Annual Art Auction Benefit, in support of the organization’s public artmaking programs. The Benefit will honor acclaimed photojournalist **Martha Cooper, Colossal Media Group, and David Goldstein**, Managing Partner of Goldstein Hall PLLC. The event will feature a silent and live auction of over 70 art works generously donated by both emerging and internationally-renowned artists, including **Martha Cooper, Swoon, Richard Serra, and Kara Walker**. Presented by the 2015 Benefit committee, led by chairs **Ricardo Cortés, Christine Haney, and Karen Jenson**, the Annual Art Auction Benefit will take place on Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at 7:00 pm at The Wythe Hotel.

Each of the 2015 honorees has made a unique contribution to Groundswell over the organization’s 19-year history, furthering its work to bring together artists, youth, and community organizations to create public art, toward a more just and equitable world.

Martha Cooper is a legendary documentary photographer. She fell in love with street culture in New York in the 1970s and has pursued this direction in her work ever since, becoming one of the most important photographers of both the graffiti and hip-hop scenes. Cooper shot the first known photos of breaking after seeing B-Boys dancing in the subway in 1980. Her documentation of New York’s graffiti art and Hip Hop scene resulted in the 1984 publication *Subway Art* in collaboration with Henry Chalfant, one of the most significant documents of this movement. Cooper is a leading photographer of her generation, traveling the world on behalf of hundreds of publications. She continues to record street scenes and street art throughout the world. Groundswell honors Cooper for her singular role in elevating public art and in helping to introduce diverse voices, talents, and perspectives to broad audiences.

Colossal Media Group is the world's largest hand painted mural and outdoor advertising company. From their headquarters in Brooklyn, Colossal's artists design and execute projects around New York and internationally, ranging from advertising and branding campaigns to major works of public art by some of the world's most famous artists. Their motto, Always Hand Paint, underlies their work, helping companies, organizations, and artists create distinctive presences in their communities. Groundswell and Colossal share the belief that talented mural artists using small-scale tools of hands, brushes, and paints to create large-scale works of art can profoundly enrich the urban environment and bring new ideas into the public sphere. Groundswell honors Colossal Media Group for their commitment to craft and for their belief that thoughtful, gorgeously executed works of art are essential to the life of a city.

David Goldstein is Managing Partner of Goldstein Hall PLLC, a law firm that focuses on affordable housing development, real estate finance, government affairs, corporate and business law and litigation. Goldstein joined Groundswell's board in 2003, and has served as Board President since 2012. He steps down from the President role in November. Under his leadership, Groundswell has grown threefold, and he has played an important role in building out structures of governance and fundraising to support this growth. Goldstein's expertise in affordable housing development, real estate finance, government affairs, and litigation have been important resources for Groundswell and have opened many doors and secured many mural sites for the organization. He is a highly-regarded expert in his field and has been involved with a wide array of issues connected to community development and housing equity. Groundswell honors Goldstein for his service to the organization and for his important role in the broader community of housing and advocacy.

Chloe Waddington of Christie's will be the auctioneer for the evening.
